Racing Rules of Sailing. All boats shall comply with N.C. Wildlife Commission and U.S. Coast Guard safety regulations. One race is planned for the Oar Race, One race is planned for the Michelob Ultra Regatta; one completed race each day will constitute each regatta.

<u>Eligibility.</u> Both Regattas are open to any mono hulled Yacht holding a current NC-PHRF Rating. Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form for each Race, and sending the forms, together with the required fees, to NYRA, PO Box 235, New Bern NC 28563 by August 21st, 2010. Late entries will be accepted, if space is available, for both regattas through the Oar Race Late

Registration September 3rd, from 7-7:30 pm. A late fee is required for any registrations received between August 22 and September 3. Online registration will be available for the Michelob Ultra Regatta at: www.mich-nyra.org

<u>Classes.</u> A minimum of three boats will constitute a class. There will be classes for spinnaker, non-spinnaker, and cruising fleets. Each fleet may be broken into multiple classes based on PHRF rating, depending on the number of entries, at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer.

Race Venue/Time. The warning signal for the Oar Race is scheduled for 11:00 am on Saturday, September 4th. The warning signal for the Michelob Ultra Regatta is scheduled for 10:00 am, Sunday, September 5th. The Sailing Instructions for both races will be available online at www.mich-nyra.org, and at registration. The Start for the Oar Race will be in the vicinity of Government Markers 17 and 19 on the Neuse River; the start of the Michelob Ultra Regatta will be in the Neuse River outside the entrance to Oriental Harbor.

<u>Michelob Ultra Regatta</u> - PHRF handicap system scored with a pursuit start. For purposes of determining start times, the non-spinnaker boats will receive 15 seconds per mile as an adjustment to their PHRF Rating. <u>Oar Race</u> - PHRF handicap system scored time on time. For purposes of determining the Overall winner of the Oar Race, non-spinnaker boats will receive 15 seconds per mile as an Adjustment to their PHRF Rating.

PHRF: A NC-PHRF Rating Request form that can be submitted for boats that do not have a current rating is available at http://www.ncphrf.com/. If you need to apply for a rating, please send the completed and signed Request Form and check no later than 3 weeks prior to the regatta to the address on the form

Awards: Up to three trophies will be awarded in each class in each Regatta, dependant on the number of entries. Actual number awarded is at the sole discretion of the Organizing Authorities for each Race. The Overall Winner of the Oar Race will have his or her name added to the perpetual trophy, and will receive a miniature replica. There will also be an award given to the top finisher from Fairfield Harbour Yacht Club. The Award Ceremony for the Oar Race will be held as soon as practical after racing on Saturday at the post race social in the Oriental Marina. The Award ceremony for the Michelob Ultra Regatta will held as soon as practical after racing on Sunday at the post race social in the New Bern Farmer's Market.

<u>Dockage.</u> Limited Dockage in the New Bern area may be available *for a reduced fee* at the New Bern Grand Marina(252) 638-0155, or at Bridgepoint Marina, or Bridgeton Harbor Marina (252) 349 1194.
