Program Times: 9:00am – 5:00pm.

Drop-off and pick-up may be no more than 15 minutes prior and 15 minutes after scheduled times (8:45 – 5:15).
A regular day will have program time from 9:00-5:00, with a lunch break sometime between 12:00-1:30.

Program Location: 290 Blackwell Point Loop Rd., Oriental NC 28571

Program Options:

Sailing Program – \$250/wk/child – This program is designed for ages 7-15 and all skill levels. Sailors will be in small groups and sail on age, size, and skill appropriate boats. Instruction will follow US Sail and ASA small boat sailing programs. Each day will consist of time for games, classroom time, and on the water instruction.

CIT (Counselor in Training) – \$250/wk/child - This program is designed for Teens (13 & older) who would like to develop both sailing and leadership skills. It will operate the same times as the Sailing Program and will consist of Sailing and Boating Instruction, Leadership Development Skills, and time assisting the Youth Sailing Programs. The CIT program will have a lead counselor who will give them direction and instruction. There is an application and interview process to participate in this program.

Optional Lunch Program – All sailors/CITs may participate in our lunch program. The Silos Restaurant provides a lunch M-F for \$25. Please check the option on the registration form if you want a catered lunch.

Other programs may be announced prior to the summer.

A \$100 deposit is required for the first registered week and a \$25 deposit is required for any remaining weeks.

All payments and deposits are non-refundable unless a two-week notice is given. If notice is less than two weeks and there is someone on the waiting list that can fill the place, a refund will be given.

Youth Sailors MUST provide their own:

- USCG approved PFD that is sized appropriately
- Water shoes that fit appropriately (preferably closed toe and NO flip flops)
- Lunch and beverage (preferably water) each day (cooler/refrigerator is NOT available)
- Water bottle full of water each day, sunscreen (already applied in the AM), hat, and sunglasses

Each sailor will be required to rig and furl their own boat, and assist others who may need help. They will also be transporting their boats on hand trailers specifically designed for the boats and lifting the boats on and off of racks.
