3. **Request to schedule Public Hearing** *Request from Mr. Lamont Jones to acquire SUP to re-open old Steamer building as Restaurant/Bar. Planning Board has submitted a request to the Board of Commissioners to schedule that hearing at their next monthly meeting (November 6), which gives the Land Use Administrator enough time to contact affected property owners and provide them an opportunity to comment at such hearing. The Planning Board is scheduled to meet October 17 and forward a recommendation on the application. (Tab 2)*
4. **Signs:** *There was some discussion following the erecting of a sign noting the stance to prevent drilling off the NC Coast last month. The Board voted in February to submit a letter of support for the effort to prevent fracking for the purpose of oil exploration off the NC Coasts, so the Manager allowed the sign to be placed.
