EVENT DETAILS

The registration and supply distribution point will be at the garage located at the corner of North Street and Third Street, directly behind the Pamlico County Courthouse.

VOLUNTEERS SHOULD:

- Only collect roadside litter.
- **DO NOT** collect trash from homeowners.
- Wear the provided safety vest.
- Be aware of traffic and avoid congested or inaccessible areas.
- For personal comfort bring water or snacks, stop when you are tired, bring sunscreen and/or bug spray, and dress appropriately for weather conditions.

WHERE TO CLEAN:

Volunteers may register to clean up roadside areas identified by Clean Sweep administrators or they may register an area they would like to clean.

- To ensure bagged litter is collected following the Clean Sweep event, volunteers should clearly identify, during registration, the areas they intend to clean. Addresses and/or GPS coordinates would be beneficial.
- Bagged litter will only be collected from roadsides from registered locations during this event.

OTHER INFORMATION

WHAT TO DO WITH COLLECTED LITTER:

- Litter collected during this event, from areas assigned or identified during registration, may be placed into the provided orange trash bags and left on the side of the road in a neat and accessible location. County personnel will collect this litter during and following this event.
- Bagged litter will only be collected from roadsides from registered locations during this event.
- Volunteers may also dispose of collected litter in a dumpster that will be placed at the Bayboro recycling location adjacent to the Pamlico County Courthouse.

FOR SAFETY WHEN COLLECTING LITTER:

- Only collect litter that is accessible.
- If it is sharp, leave it alone (broken glass, needles, etc.).
- If you find large or heavy objects that cannot be bagged, move these to the side of the road next to bagged litter, but not in the roadway.
- Items that cannot be moved or generate questions for safety, leave in place and report these to Clean Sweep administrators.
