Trash – Let's find out why dumpster's will not work – Cost? Location? Maybe we get volunteers to help collect bagged trash. Tourism Board pay for the dumpster?

Volunteers – I believe we can get volunteers. How many do we need, days, locations, etc.

Other. Some thoughts.

We need to bend over backwards to make this event happen and compromise on issues.

- No parking and towing.
 - Town making "No Parking" signs is great.
 - Towing should be our last option. Towing can be confusing, cause conflict and difficulty for our visitors.
 - I would suggest we look at contacting the owners before towing.
 - Nick and Bill I assume can check NC tags and obtain the name of the owner. I don't know about out of state tags.
 - We can ask CycleNC to register the state and tag number of their group on their registration form or when they arrive.
 - If we can give CycleNC the name the car owner they can locate the owner through their communication system and probably have the issue corrected before having a car towed.
 - This would also be good for other issues with their cars that might come up – Flat tire, car hit by another car, break end, etc.
- Entertainment – I assume this is at the river and not – Red Rooster, Tiki Bar, Brewery, O'Town, etc. Maybe the Ol' Front Porch Festival would like to do an event for them or other entertainers would like to perform. Where, date, time, etc. Tourism Board could sponsor a band.
- Registration at Town Hall – I would like for us to consider some options before they go to the river unless that is where they want to be. South Street will be closed, cars parked on both sides of the Freemason Street and no turn around? Is his correct?
 - I do not remember how long this set up is needed – Thursday/Friday only or the whole weekend. I also assume it could be moved after Friday. I don't know.
 - Issues at Town Hall were more tents/RV's than we expected and people leaving out onto Broad Street.
 - Do they need the RV's at the property with the tents?
 - If yes can we arrange them to make it work?
 - If no it should work with some changes below.
 - Make the entrance and exit onto the property from Broad both entrances only and they can loop around Townhall to Church Street to exit. We can put no parking on Church St. from Broad to the first entrance at the Old Schoolhouse. This would keep a reduce congestion around the exit and better visibility of oncoming traffic. If the RV's are needed on site only have one entrance and put the RV's on the side of the property where the entrance is blocked. Need the Baptist onboard.
 - If this is not acceptable then consider the Methodist Church. Make 3rd avenue from Church/Freemason one lane and one way to Mildred. They can use the gravel parking lot along 3rd avenue for their tents and park their RV's in the church grass parking lot.
 - See if the old Town and Country would be available.
 - Use the fire station. There is plenty of room to the right and cars can loop around the fire station to exit. They could register coming into Town.
