

WELCOME ENTREPRENEURS:
Starting a Business or Expanding a Business

The Small Business Center (SBC) is offering a series of seven three-hour entrepreneur seminars titled, **The Entrepreneurs Guide to Starting and Managing a Small Business**. The seven-week program will meet once a week for seven weeks and those who complete all seven sessions will be awarded a certificate from the Small Business Center. Those who cannot attend all sessions can sign up for individual sessions as needed and will be awarded a certificate with the number of hours attended. The seven-week sessions will be held at the Bayboro Center October 4-November 15 (Thursdays) from 6:00-9:00 p.m. and presented by Mike Marsh. The topics each week will include:

- October 4 - How to Start a Business
- October 11 - Financing your Small Business
- October 18 - How to write a Business Plan
- October 25 - How to Find your Customers
- November 1 - Basics of Bookkeeping
- October 8 - Your Small Business Taxes
- November 15 - Marketing your Small Business

Small business seminars are offered free by the Small Business Center. There will be time allowed during each training session to use the PCs in the Bayboro Center computer lab to work on the business planning process.

If you are serious about starting a small business or expanding a business in North Carolina, this training will help you get started. Whatever your level of experience, this training will provide information we hope you will find useful while doing business in Pamlico County and North Carolina.
