

WNC Disaster Response Collection at Station 19

Materials we'll be collecting:

Because they're going to an existing distribution site, we can only accept these items at this time. We'll let you know when things change.

Flood buckets/Cleaning kits (packed buckets are great; if not, just bring whatever of the items on the list that you can find)



- 5 gallon bucket with lid
- 32-64 oz bottle of liquid laundry detergent
- 16-40 oz household cleaner concentrate
- 16-34 oz dish soap
- Pump bottle of insect repellent or 10-20 wipes
- 4-8 oz pump spray liquid air freshener
- Scrub brush
- 5 steel wool scouring pads w/o soap
- 36-50 clothespins
- 50-100 ft clothesline
- 2 dozen 33-45 gallon heavy trash bags
- 18 reusable wipes (no terrycloth, microfiber, or paper towels)
- 5 N95 dust masks
- 1 pair leather or cotton work gloves with leather palm
- 2 pairs reusable kitchen gloves

Hygiene kits (completed kits welcome or just bring whatever parts you can find. All items must be new and unwashed):

- One hand towel (15 x 25 –17 x 27 inches—No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels)
- One washcloth
- One comb; Must be sturdy with at least 4-7 inches of teeth.
- One toenail or fingernail clipper—No emery boards or metal nail files
- Bath-size soap in original packaging; (3 oz. bar or larger; not Ivory or Jergens)
- One adult toothbrush in original packaging—no advertising
- 10 adhesive bandages (¾ by 3 inches)
- One one-gallon size re-sealable bag

- Lay hand towel flat on a table.
- Lay the washcloth in the center of the hand towel.
- Place all remaining items on top of the washcloth (except the plastic bag).
- Fold the sides of the hand towel to cover the items.
- Grasp the bundle tightly and roll over the remainder of the towel.
- Place the tightly rolled bundle in the plastic bag, remove air, and seal.

Menstrual Hygiene Kit Materials

- One one-gallon size re-sealable bag
- Two 2 oz. bottle hand sanitizer
- Three 4-gallon bathroom trash bags
- One travel pack of wet ones
- 10 Tampons, unscented (5 regular and 5 super absorbency)
- 10 long super ultrathin unscented Sanitary Napkins
- Bath-size soap in original packaging. (3 oz. bar or larger, not Ivory or Jergens))
- One pack of flushable wipes, unscented (42 count)
- Six laundry detergent sheets
 - Laundry detergent sheets should be placed inside of a small plastic storage bag prior to being added to the kit

Assembly Directions

- Start with a one-gallon resealable bag.
- Place one pack of the flushable wipes and wet wipes in the bag.
- Place three 4-gallon bathroom trash bags and the 10 sanitary napkins in the bag.
- Then, add the smaller items in the plastic bag, remove air, and seal.
