The Town Board of Oriental Town Board Meeting on November 5, 2019 was called to order at 8pm. Mayor Belangia determined a quorum to be present and called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Approval of Agenda: Need to amend Agenda to cancel #4- Public Hearing.

13 4. Public Hearing The Public Hearing scheduled and noticed for revision to the Town's Sign Ordinance in the 14 GMO will be cancelled. The Planning Board, following direction from the Town Board on issues to address, ran 15 into several unintended consequences that may be unacceptable. Following this issue and legal counsel, the 16 Planning Board (10-25-19) and Town Board (10-31-19) agree that more work needs to be done to (a) solve the 17 perceived issues while (b) preventing unintended consequences and (c) making the revision complete, by addressing 18 the potential inconsistencies between the 1998 version of the Ordinance and Statute/case law adjudicated in 2016 19 which may affect the enforceability of the Ordinance. Manager notes that issues arose from discussion and legal 20 counsel concerning the defensibility of existing Ordinance WRT Case Law from 2016- recommending we look at 21 the entire Ordinance. The Manager, in her capacity as Land Use Administrator will follow attorney 22 recommendations and present a draft to the Planning Board that hopefully will address the original concerns, yet 23 revise the Ordinance to be defensible. Should look to come back to the Town Board following the Holidays for 24 maximum participation in the process.
