



CALL FOR ENTRIES & APPLICATION FORM

The Pamlico County Arts Council invites photographers to participate in a photography exhibition:

Portraits of Pamlico

Capture the essence of Pamlico County

Through photography, introduce the likeness, personality and even the mood of our county.

This will be a one day showcase of photographic artworks held at the New Village Brewery in Oriental, NC on Saturday, April 13, 2019. The exhibition is planned to run concurrent with the Oriental In-Water Boat Show which attracts thousands to Oriental for the 3 day event, providing a great opportunity for exposure for participating photographers.

The work will be showcased in outdoor exhibition tents at the brewery. Thus, a rain date will be set for April 14, 2019. Work must be submitted framed and ready to hang. Use framing wire, no sawtooth hangers.

First place awardees in each category will receive \$50. Second and third place ribbons will be awarded as well. Each of the following categories will have awards for color and awards for black and white.

Scenic

Nautical

Wildlife

Pets

Portrait

Still Life

Photojournalism

All photographs must be taken in Pamlico County.

Photographers may submit up to 2 works in each category.

The photos will be judged by quality as well as how closely they reflect the theme of the show and the category.

Photographs should not be larger than 8 x 10 (exclusive of matting and framing), and need to be framed and ready to hang.

Fees are as follows:

Non-Members: \$20 for the first photograph and \$10 for each additional photograph.

Members of PCAC: \$10 for the first photograph and \$5 for each additional photograph

Photographers 18 and younger (please provide proof of age when submitting work): First 2 images are free, additional images: \$5 each for members, \$10 each for non-members. Images will be judged by the same criteria as adults.

Photographer Jurors:

Katharine Schroeder has been an award-winning professional photographer for over a decade, but her passion for photography began at a young age when she borrowed her mom's Brownie Hawkeye to photograph her dolls. More recently, she spent nine years working as a photojournalist for a weekly paper in New York and ran her own business photographing children, pets, and events. For three-plus years a decade ago, she lived in Hong Kong working for the actor Jackie Chan, traveling with him and photographing his charity work and film career.

Adrian Henson has earned his PPA Master of Photography, Master of Electronic Imaging and Photographic Craftsman degrees, and he is a Certified Professional Photographer. Adrian is heavily involved with his

state organization (Professional Photographers of North Carolina) as well as being a PPA Councilor. He regularly travels throughout the country teaching and speaking and is an International Photographic Competition Juror in Training. He is very committed to photographic competition and has been honored with the Diamond, Platinum, Gold and Bronze awards as well as North Carolina's Photographer of the Year award and SEPPA's Best in Show, just to name a few.

John Angelo's love of all things coastal led him into photographing the beautiful areas in and around the Crystal Coast and pursuing a degree in Portrait Photography. He has been photographing full time and professionally since 2005. After completing his degree he moved to New Bern and opened his first portrait studio with his wife, Brandy. For years they have photographed portraits, weddings, events, products, schools, and business services such as architectural photography, real estate, group business portraits and more. His commercial photography is used by companies such as Walmart, US Air Force, Community Coffee, Unilever and others.
