Pamlico County Reports Sixth (6th) Death Related to COVID-19

The Pamlico County Health Department is reporting the sixth (6th) COVID-19 associated death in Pamlico County.

The individual died on January 9th, 2021 from complications associated with the virus. The patient was 78 years old and had several underlying medical conditions. To protect the families' privacy, no further information about this patient will be released.

WEAR a face covering over your nose and mouth

WAIT Six (6) Feet apart, avoiding close contact
