I had the following telephone conversations 11/21/23 - Ms. White, NC League of Municipalities 11/22/23 - Mr. Davis, Town of Oriental Attorney

1. Question: Is the formation of a Financial Liaison in a Council Manager form of government precluded by North Carolina statute?

Ms. White's response:

The North Carolina statute does not contain language which prohibits the formation of a Financial Liaison. However, Ms. White advises against following this course of action, as it may cause issue with the Town Manager. Ms. White's recommendation would be to request copies of the review documents.

Mr. Davis's response:

The North Carolina statute does not contain language which prohibits the formation of a Financial Liaison. However, Mr. Davis advises against following this course of action, as it may cause issues with the Town staff. Recommendation would be to prepared copies of the of the review documents for each Commissioner.
