## System Pressure Advisory/Unscheduled Outage

The water consumers of Pamlico County Water System will experience periods of low pressure and outages in the distribution system due to replacing a damaged valve. Water department contractors are making repairs to the system around 11am. The following areas are covered under the advisory:

Residents starting at the intersection of Roberts Rd and Neuse Rd continuing to 8195 Neuse Rd. Also from or around 1973 Goose Creek Rd to the intersection of Neuse Rd and Kennels Beach Rd, along with Kennels Beach Rd. This includes any other adjacent roads such as Chestnutt, Live Oak, Mimosa, Pecan Pine, Beech, Woola Woola, Rollo, Live Oak Ext.

This area may extend to other roads at any moment if necessary to complete repair and notice will be placed on county website. [https://www.pamlicocounty.org/county\\_government/public\\_notices/index.php](https://www.pamlicocounty.org/county_government/public_notices/index.php)

Periods of low or no pressure in the distribution system increases the potential for back siphonage and introduction of bacteria into the water system.

Therefore, the Pamlico County Water Department advises that when water is restored consumers **boil all water** used for human consumption (including drinking, cooking, brushing teeth, making ice and washing hands) or use bottled water.

Vigorous boiling for one (1) minute should kill any disease-causing organisms that may be present in the water.

This office is strongly urging the water consumers to conserve water whenever possible. This advisory remains in effect until sample results are returned (24-48 hours) and when further written notification is issued.
